The roots of the Notting Hill Carnival are said to originate in Trinidad and Tobago, a small island country in the Caribbean. To create the theme of the carnival each year, the organizers look at the historical and cultural models that continue to come out of Africa and the Caribbean. The organizers say that they also want to show the benefits and difficulties created by the influence of the traditions that Europeans brought to their native countries. They believe that this type of information makes the carnival educational as well as entertaining. The young and old come together to remember the traditional times. Food is a major part of the festival. Foods from West Africa to Asia mean that there is something for everyone to enjoy. The Notting Hill Carnival promises to be a place where ideas are translated into designs. Balance, colors, rhythms, and movements expose new themes to the people each year. Why does the ocean move? What causes the waves? Blowing winds move the water on the surface of the ocean. There are consistent winds that travel across the world's oceans, creating surface currents. Cold winds that blow from the North and South Poles carry cold water toward the warm, central parts of the Earth. At the same time, surface currents from these warm, central parts shift warm water toward the North Pole and the South Pole. As the Earth turns from east to west, that turning also causes currents to move.

Another thing that makes ocean water move is temperature. Cold water is denser than warm water. Cold water sinks while warm water rises up. The deeper you go into the ocean, the colder the water is. Deep beneath the surface, large streams of cold water move in very long underwater currents. As the water moves, some of it begins to warm up. Then the cooler water underneath pushes the warm water to the surface. This interaction between cold water and warm water is what makes water move below the surface.

The influence of the moon and the sun helps move the water in the ocean by creating tides. At high tide, water covers more of the beach because it has been pulled higher by the influence of the moon and the sun. At low tide, the water is farther away. Tides <u>vary</u> in strength daily and seasonally. All these elements work together to create the motion of the seas.
